Jailed for fighting terrorism

Gerardo Hernández, René González, Ramón Labañino, Antonio Guerrero and Fernando González – incarcerated for 10 years in US jails for working to expose terrorist groups operating in Miami against Cuba.

Members of their families have been denied visas to visit their loved ones. The United Nations Working Group on Arbitrary Detention and Amnesty International have both condemned the trial and denial of family visiting rights.
